Bret Stephens is the Foreign Affairs Columnist and member of the Wall Street Journal Editorial Board. He took over as the regular writer of "Global View", a column appearing every Tuesday. Stephens previously worked as an editorial writer for the Wall Street Journal Europe, in Brussels. Between 2002 and 2004 he was editor-in-chief of the Jerusalem Post, a position that he assumed at the age of 28.
